Can you tell the difference between flu and a bad cold?

Many people think they've had the flu when it's actually just a cold. Here's how to tell the difference:

Symptom	Cold	Flu
Fever	Uncommon	Usually; high; lasts 3 to 4 days
HEADACHE	Uncommon	Very common
ACHES AND PAINS	Slight	Common and often severe
FATIGUE AND WEAKNESS	Mild	Significant; can last 2 to 3 weeks
EXTREME EXHAUSTION	Never	Very common at the start
STUFFY NOSE	Common	Sometimes
SNEEZING	Common	Sometimes
SORE THROAT	Common	Sometimes
CHEST DISCOMFORT AND COUGH	Common; mild to moderate; hacking cough	Common; often severe; painful cough

For most people, the flu lasts 3 to 7 days, but it can last for longer than 2 weeks.
